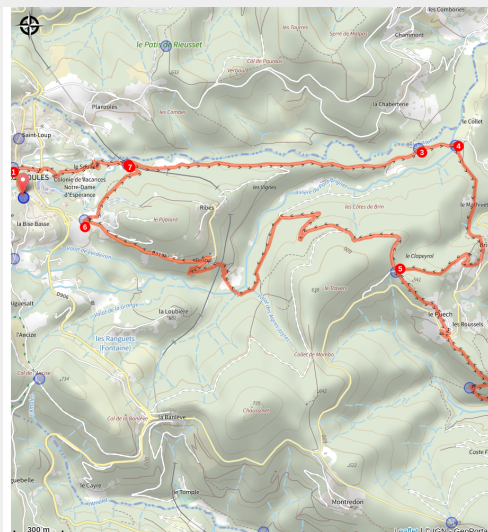

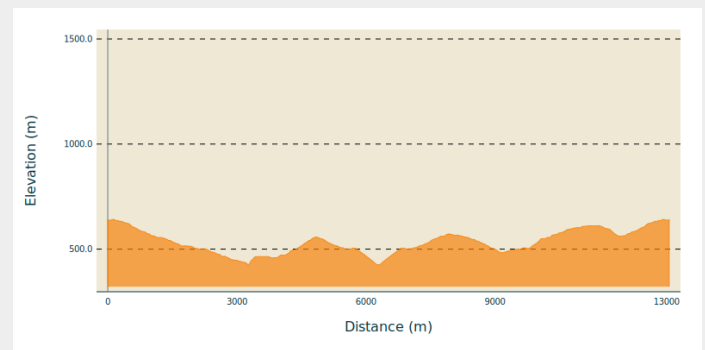

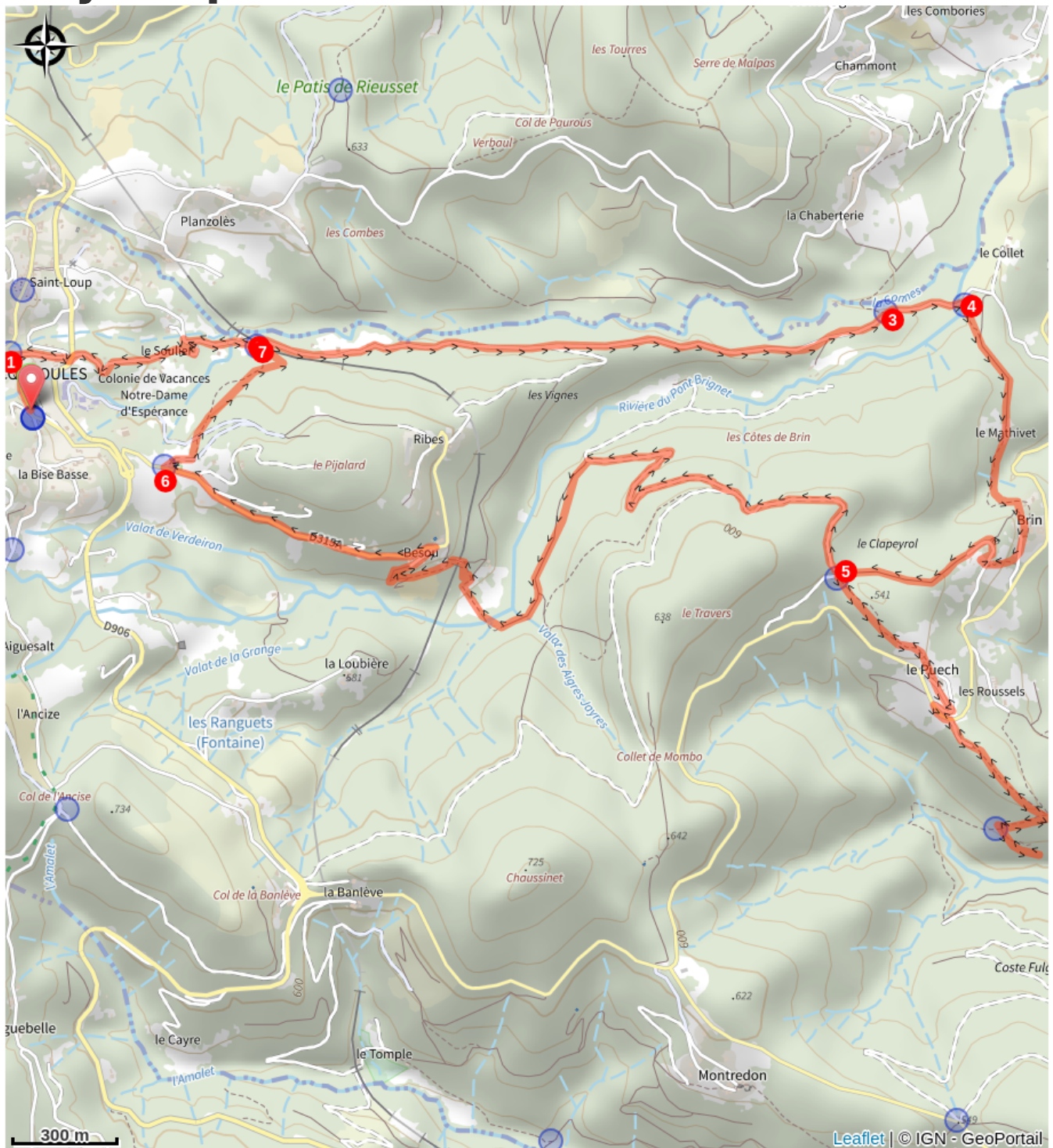
Signposts will guide you all along this route. In the description below, the signposted place names and/or directions are given in **bold italics** between quotation marks :

From "**Concoules**" walk to :

1. "**Cimetière**",
2. "**Station Epuration**". Continue straight ahead to :
3. "**Moulin du Champ Blanc**",
4. "**Ruisseau de la Conne**",
5. "**Le Clapeyrol**". From here, walk to "**La Grotte des Baumes**", then retrace your steps. Back at "**Le Clapeyrol**" (5), return to "**Concoules**" via :
6. "**La Bise Basse**",
7. "**Station Epuration**" and "**Cimetière**".
